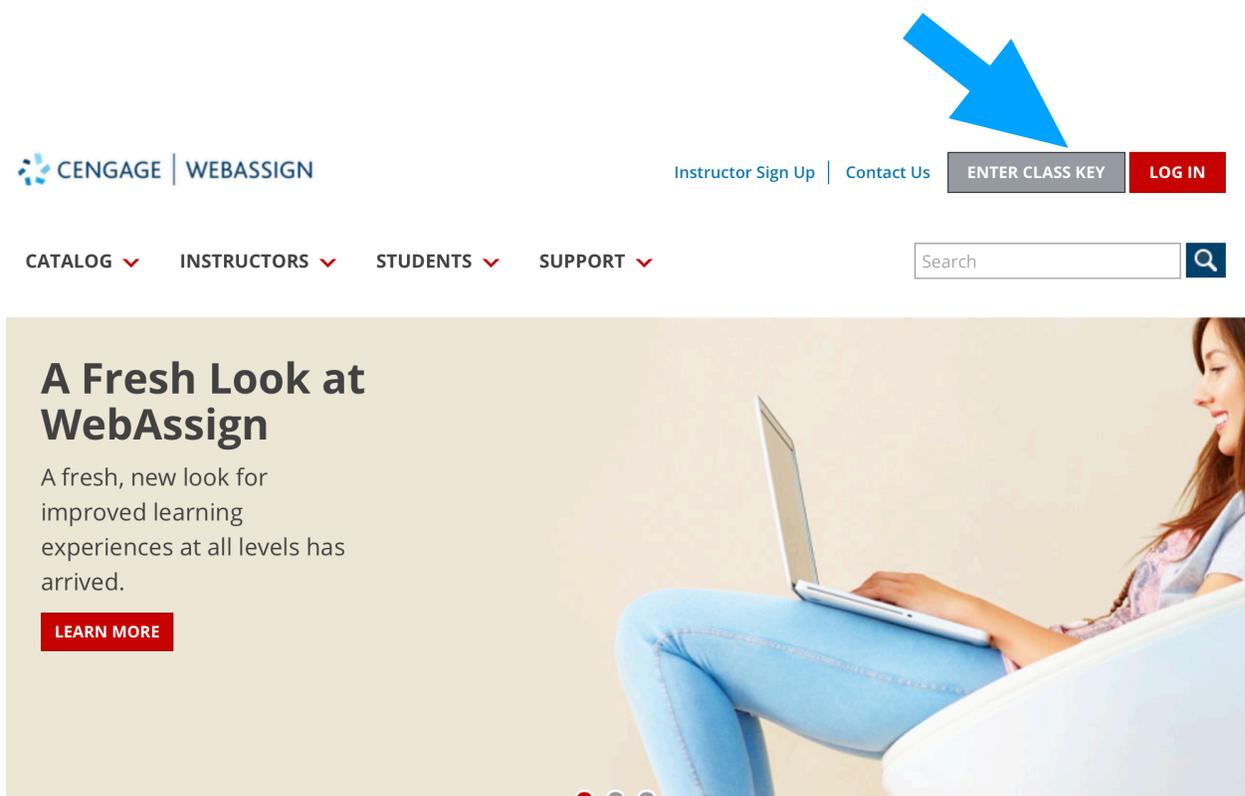


How to set up your online Calculus course - Math 1508

Go to the web page webassign.net. It will look like the screen shot below. Click in the upper right corner - the grey box that says enter class key

as in the image below

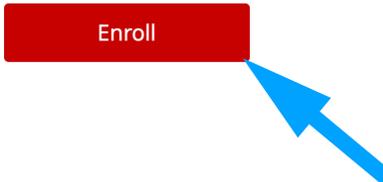
And click on **“enroll”**
