Course Objectives:

1. Learn to play a Renaissance instrument, or sing in early music styles.
2. Understand basic Renaissance performance practice methods.
3. Learn to perform effectively as part of a chamber group.
4. Become familiar with some Renaissance styles, genres, and composers.
