Course Objectives: The course will cover the following sections:
- Structure of 3D space and learn to graphically display functions of 2 and 3 variables.
- Use of vectors to describe motion and forces in 2D and 3D space.
- Compute partial derivatives of multivariate functions, and to use them in applications such as finding minima and maxima.
- Compute multiple integrals and to use them in applications such as volume, mass and centroid calculations.
